From here, you will take Concord Bus to Tilton, NH. It will take about 2.5 hours and costs about \$25. Please check out **www.concordcoachlines.com** for the detail. The bus departs directly from the arrivals /baggage area. Ask a transit policeman to direct you to the correct waiting spot.

Please make sure your employer knows what time do you plan on arriving at Tilton bus station (or Meredith, NH). They will pick you up at the bus station during reasonable time. (8am to 8pm) Taxi information: Mr. C's: 603-267-7134 / Belmont Taxi: 603-387-5697

Please contact Bob / Sam 30 minutes before your arrive at Tilton (Meredith) bus station, if they will pick you up.

IMPORTANT:

Please remember if you will not be able to make it to your housing during reasonable hours-8:00am to 8:00pm, you need to stay overnight and travel the following day. The bus ALSO departs from Boston South Station. If you have spent the night in the city, depart from here, as it will be easier and much less expensive.
